Health Bus visits every other week; call for day/times.

Public Dining Room provides noon and evening meals to the public.

Noon Meal Sign-up: 11 a.m. to 12 p.m.

Evening Meal Sign-up: 6 p.m. to 7 p.m.

Food Pantry distributes baskets of food to those with a residence. Must have ID for everyone in household, proof of income, recent rent receipt. Must stay through the noon meal. Once every 60 days.

Sign-in Days/Times:

Monday - Friday 11 a.m. to 11:45 a.m.

Personal Hygiene Items available to those in need once every 60 days. You must have ID for all and stay through the noon meal.

Sign-in Days/Times:

Monday - Friday 11 a.m. to 11:45 a.m.

Shelter for Men is available on an as-need basis. Capacity for 60 men.

Sign-in Time: 6 p.m. to 7 p.m.

Transformation Program a one-year, in-house, Bible based rehabilitation program for men seeking to overcome addictions. Space available for 12 men. Applicants need to apply in person and interview with the Program Manager.
